

Heikki Uimonen (*Doctor of Philosophy*) holds a post of professor at the University of Eastern Finland (2022–2023). He held professorships at University of the Arts (2012–2017) and University of Eastern Finland (2020–2021). He is an ethnomusicologist and a docent on acoustic communication and soundscape studies at the University of Eastern Finland and University of Tampere and recording and performing musician. Uimonen has published and co-published articles, monographs and edited anthologies on music consumption, radio music, compact cassettes, background music and transforming sensory environments. His research interests include sonic construction of place, mediated music, social use of music, transforming sensory environments and how all these intertwine. He is the vice chair of Finnish Society for Acoustic Ecology.

Uimonen directed project ACMESOCS. Auditory Cultures, Mediated Sounds and Constructed Spaces (2019–2022) and is currently directing European Commission financed Finnish team on multinational B-Air Art Infinity Radio Creating Sound Art for Babies, Toddlers and Vulnerable Groups project (2020–2024). He has examined how contemporary audio technology can be used in soundscape participatory research and led projects *Transforming Finnish Soundscapes* and sub-project on *Health Supporting Multisensory Food Environment*. Uimonen was a member of COST project standardising soundscape concept in Europe. He has worked as a member of the research groups investigating six European villages and European acoustic heritage defining, describing and analysing sound cultures of Europe and in project SENSOTRA studying sensory environments of cities of Turku, Brighton and Ljubljana.
