**David Voas** is a Professor at University College London, where he led the UCL Social Research Institute until 2020. He is a demographer and sociologist of religion. David was the European Values Study National Programme Director for Great Britain from 2008 to 2020 and served on the EVS Executive Committee for most of that period. He is co-director of *British Religion in Numbers* and a member of the editorial boards of the *British Journal of Sociology* and the *Journal for the Scientific Study of Religion*.

**Jörg Stolz**, is a Full Professor of the Sociology of Religion at the University of Lausanne. His work combines quantitative and qualitative methods to study different forms of religiosity, evangelicalism, religious diversity, secularization, and islamophobia. He is the past president of the ISSR and the first author of *(Un)Believing in modern society* (Routledge).

**Margaret van der Es** is an Assistant Professor of Religious Studies at University of Utrecht. Her research field lies at the intersection of religion, media, gender, food, cosmopolitanism, and belonging, with special focus on Muslims in Europe. Her expertise will be especially beneficial for WP2 and WP3.
